- Those wishing to volunteer for Super Bowl XLIV must complete the official South Florida Super Bowl Host Committee Ambassador Application.
- Each applicant must complete a waiver of liability and indemnification agreement.
- Each applicant must consent to a mandatory FBI background check for security reasons.
- All Ambassadors must be 18 years of age by November 30, 2009. A driver's license or state identification may be used as proof.
- Ambassadors must be available to work a minimum of two 5-hour shifts.
- Ambassadors must attend one training session specific to their selected assignment. Training will take place in the evenings and on weekends in Fall 2009.
- No game tickets to Pro Bowl 2010 or Super Bowl XLIV will be provided to Ambassadors.
- No Ambassador opportunities are available in Dolphin Stadium on Super Bowl XLIV or Pro Bowl 2010 game day.
- Ambassadors must provide their own transportation to their assigned shift.
- Opportunities to volunteer will be provided on an equal opportunity basis without regard to age, sex, race, religion or disabilities.
